2024 Lenten Regulations

The days of both Fast and Abstinence during lent are Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. The other Fridays of Lent are days of Abstinence.

On a day of Fast, only one (1) full meal is permitted, and two (2) smaller meals, which if added together would not exceed the main meal in quantity. Those between the ages of 18 and 59 are obliged to fast.

On a day of Abstinence, no meat may be eaten. Those who have reached the age of 14 are obliged by the law of Abstinence. The time for fulfilling the Paschal Precept (Easter Duty) extends from the First Sunday in Lent, February 18th to the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity, May 26th.
