Church Bathroom Renovation Work Begins

As part of our ongoing Capital Improvement Projects to upgrade and restore our church building, we begin the renovation work to the church restroom facilities with construction of two bathrooms in place of the one old bathroom which does not provide us with modern facilities for use by parishioners attending Mass, sacraments and celebrations.

Work will begin the week of Monday, June

23rd and is expected to take approximately 3 months to complete. During construction, the only bathroom facilities for use will be portable bathrooms located outside the Sacred Heart entrance.

Additionally, to allow the construction workers optimal time to complete the work during the day, Monday-Friday Daily Mass will be celebrated in the Chapel located in the Saint Joseph Center (the former Convent Building) utilizing the main front door entrance. The church will otherwise remain open for prayer utilizing the Ridge Road and Sacred Heart entrances. Saturday and Sunday liturgies, as well as all baptisms, weddings and funerals will continue to be celebrated in the church. During this time there will be no streaming of the masses during the weekdays.
